At time of application, applicant must:

- Be one of a high school senior in Fall 2017; a high school graduate/college-bound student as of June 2017; or a current college freshman.
- Be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident.
- Reside in Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New York, Rhode Island or Vermont. *Preference is given to Connecticut residents.*
- Be currently taking or have already taken Calculus AB or BC. *Pre-calculus will not be considered.*

Completed application is due postmarked by mail, or submitted by e-mail, no later than May 19, 2017. All sections are required. See bottom of page for submission details. Camp participants are selected by a blind, weighted analysis of the information they supply as part of this application. Accepted applicants will be notified the week beginning June 12, 2017.
